EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT RECOVERY COACHING PROGRAM

This program received 4,865 referrals from a total of 29 hospitals.



7 additional hospitals were added to the roster this year.

Recovery Coaches received 589 referrals from the Hartford Hospital Inpatient floors initiative.

The program hired 7 new Recovery Coaches, 2 Lead Recovery Coaches and 2 Regional Managers.



Recovery Coaches assisted in linking recoverees to care with 46 different community providers.

DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS RECOVERY COACHING PROGRAM

There were 414 individuals referred to the program in the past year, with 200 current active participants.

Coaches had 705 in-person meetings and 4,512 coaching phone conversations.

Recovery coaches spent approximately 200 hours with individuals involved with police or emergency services in Manchester, CT through the Manchester HOPE Initiative.

In July 2022, Recovery Coaches began supporting Jail Diversion programs in the Bridgeport, Hartford and Waterbury Courthouses.

3 coaches were hired to provide services to these areas.



They have connected with 46 recoverees in 535 coaching conversations. Everyone has a story, and for many CCAR is a crucial part of that story and their recovery.

There are numerous individuals who have involvement with CCAR that choose to sustain that impact.

43% of CCAR employees have had previous involvement with the organization, whether it be in a Recovery Community Center, the Telephone Recovery Support

program, or another CCAR branch.


